Metro Dining Club Cards

Have you purchased your **Metro Dining Club Cards** yet? This yearly Heritage Center fundraiser is a "win-win" opportunity for you & your family. With these cards you can enjoy an entire year of 2-for-1 dining in many south of the river restaurants. Just present each restaurant's card once a month and receive a second meal free or, in some establishments, enjoy a meal for a discounted price.

Each 166-card set usually sells for \$28, but you can purchase them for only \$22 at the Heritage Center office.

An example of possible savings: If you used only one card at Pizza Man and received the monthly \$6 savings on a large pizza, you would save \$72 over the year. That's a big return for a \$22 investment, and you've used only one of the many cards available to you.
